The proposal should be in English, include an abstract of 200-300 words, along with a short bio of no longer than 200 words, and should be submitted to Ms. Alix Ng at **an@hcch.nl** (HCCH Asia Pacific Regional Office).

The event is jointly sponsored by the Hague Conference on Private International Law (HCCH) and the Department of Justice of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region of the People's Republic of China, in collaboration with various other partners. It will be held from 9 to 11 November 2015, and will provide an important opportunity to meet key players in the field of family law and discuss developments in the Asia Pacific region.
